The Asian Natural Environmental Science Center, The University of Tokyo, Japan, invites applications for a tenured position at the Associate Professor level.

Job Description:

The successful candidate will conduct both basic research as well as applied field research to study on environmental tolerance mechanisms of trees and on development of environmental reforestation techniques in Asia. The candidate will also participate in teaching programs in the Department of Forest Science, the Graduate School of Agricultural and Life Sciences, The University of Tokyo. The earliest starting date is April 1st, 2016.

Requirements:

- (1) A doctoral degree.
- (2) Outstanding achievements both in research and in teaching and records of social contributions, and strong motivation and potential for conducting research and teaching students in the research area described in the Job Description.
- (3) Experience in international collaborative research in Asia, and willingness to take an initiative in international collaborative research through promoting research programs of the Center.

All applications will be considered equally regardless of nationality and gender.

- (2) Publication list, which is divided into original articles, review papers and others
- (3) Previous educational achievements
- (4) Previous social contributions
- (5) Previous international collaborative research achievement in Asian region
- (6) Significance of your research activities and your future research plan (A4, two pages)
- (7) Teaching policy (A4, one page)
- (8) Contact information for two professional references (name, affiliation, telephone

number, e-mail address)

The application must be received by March 7, 2016.

Selection Process:

The most competent candidate will be nominated by the Search Committee to the Steering Committee for the Center. If necessary, the candidate would be invited for an interview before the nomination. The final decision will be made by voting among the Steering Committee members. The submitted application materials will not be returned.
