【Additional notice】 Leave of absence associated with the Tohoku Region Earthquake for MONBUKAGAKUSHO (MEXT) Scholarship Students

This is an additional notice regarding leave of absence associated with the Tohoku Region Earthquake for MONBUKAGAKUSHO (MEXT) Scholarship students.

If students who have applied for leave of absence as per the notification dated April 12, 2011 wish to extend the period of absence, they may be asked to submit documents issued by the government of their home country indicating the need to evacuate from Japan etc. Please note that it is possible to shorten the period of absence without submitting any additional documents.

Master's course of our graduate school starts in April and ends in March. Hence, master's students wishing to take leave are advised to apply for one year leave of absence (two semesters). However, the doctoral students are advised to apply for one semester or one year leave of absence. In any case, the period of absence will be considered to begin from April 1, 2011.
