

Issuance of the “Letter of Acceptance” for MONBUKAGAKUSHO (MEXT) Scholarship applicants

International students join our graduate school as a research student (from April or Oct), pass the entrance exam held for international students in February of the following year and then enroll for the regular course (doctoral or masters) from April.

Those who have passed the preliminary selection of the Japanese Embassy and are interested in obtaining the “Letter of Acceptance” from our graduate school must provide the following documents/ details by August end:

1. Letter from the Japanese Embassy informing you of passing the pre-selection exam
2. Application form submitted to the embassy for MONBUKAGAKUSHO Scholarship (complete set including the photograph attached application form, research proposal, recommendation letters, health certificate etc).

Most embassies return a stamped copy of the application to the candidate along with the notification of passing the preliminary selection examination. Please send a copy of this stamped application received from the embassy.

3. Attachment: After sending the “Attachment” form to the embassy along with the “Letter(s) of Acceptance” and the names of the Universities/ Professors contacted, please send a copy of this form “Attachment” to us for our reference.
4. From the following homepage of our graduate school, in accordance with the research proposal submitted along with the application, identify the laboratory suitable for your research interest:

In your request letter, write the name of the laboratory and professor you wish to work with.

5. Copy of the transcripts and degree certificates (originals not required).
