# Registration for Scholarship Application –Spring 2020

Self-funded international students who wish to apply for scholarships offered by private foundations and research institutions through the university are required to register their personal information beforehand. <u>Students who registered in the previous terms must also</u> <u>submit the documents for the new academic year during the specified period if they wish to have their information in the register.</u>

<u>New registrations and/or changes in the registered information after the specified period will</u> <u>not be accepted.</u>

## $\star$ Applicable scholarships:

<u>Scholarships offered by private organizations which require the nomination from the university.</u> In principle, you are required to do this registration to apply for the following scholarships as well as the scholarships requiring the university recommendation, however, registration within each deadline of the following scholarships is also acceptable in case you fail to register by the deadline shown on the next page.

- MONBUKAGAKUSHO Scholarship (recruitment within Japan)
- The University of Tokyo Fellowship
- The University of Tokyo's Support Foundation Scholarship for International Students
- Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students

## ★Eligibility:

Self-supporting international students enrolled in the Graduate School of Agricultural and Life Sciences/Faculty of Agriculture (except for the research students) as of April 2020.

\*Those who fall under the following categories are not eligible to register (\*):

- Recipients of the University of Tokyo Fellowship
- Recipients of the Japan Society for Promotion of Science (JSPS) Fellowship
- China Scholarship Council Students
- Students dispatched by foreign governments
- Students receiving other scholarships or salaries, etc. while holding a position in a government agency or a company in their home country

\*However, if the scholarship grant period will end in Spring 2020, recipients of the mentioned scholarships above are also eligible to register.

### $\star$ Documents to be submitted:

- (1) <u>Application Form for Scholarships from Private Foundations</u>
  \*Here is a reference for English version but make sure to use the Japanese form.
- (2) <u>Questionnaire for Private Foundation Scholarships (Form 1)</u>
- (3) List of Achievements (Annex)
- (4) Photocopy of transcripts (from the undergraduate course to the current course)\*If photocopies of the certificates have already been submitted during the previous registration, submit only the additional/updated certificates, if any.
- (5) Photocopies of published articles on journals(first page only), notice of publication, and details of poster and oral presentation. (if you have already submitted, only additional records can be submitted.)
  - Ex) Publications: 1<sup>st</sup> page of the paper, the notice of acceptance etc. (make sure to include your name, publisher, and date etc.)

Presentations: your materials, emails with a person related to a conference, etc.

Awards: photocopy of the certificate, notice of settlement, etc.
