**Level-check Interview:** Wednesday July 31

\*If you are not available on the day, you will have a 10-minute placement interview test at Nichibeï Kaiwa Gakuin on 8/1 or 8/2.

**Class Size:** Approximately 6-8 students per class

### Eligibility:

- Applicants must be an undergraduate or graduate student at Yayoi campus as of September 1, 2019 (Current Research Students are not qualified.)
- Students whose attendance falls below the minimum attendance requirement (80%) are ineligible for this course.

- Avoid a last minute cancellation.
