In this department, professors are required to comment on research in other fields at thesis presentations. In addition, since there are many international students enrolled in the International Program in Agricultural Development Studies (IPADS) in this department, we expect that he/she will actively accept overseas students and provide education guidance. 19	Additional Information	1) The application documents will not be returned to the applicants. 2) Personal information received through this application process will be only used for the purpose of selecting candidates (not be used for any other purposes). 3) Smoking is strictly prohibited on the University premise except for a limited number of designated smoking plots located outside of buildings. 4) At the time of employment, any persons who are under contract with any foreign government or foreign institutions, or any persons who are receiving money or any other benefits from any foreign government or foreign institutions, can be subject to the restrictions provided by Japanese laws including Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act that regulates sharing of certain technologies with foreign entities.
