The University of Tokyo is accepting application for TIEC Residence Hall rooms (from here on referred as Residence Hall).

Students who wish to live in Residence Hall rooms are required to submit documents specified below during the set application period.

Please note that the selection process is carried out by TIEC and not the University of Tokyo.

1. Type of room and rent

- ▲ As the final selection is made by TIEC, the receipt of application by the University does not guarantee allocation of rooms
- ▲ Internet connection services must be done by the individual students.

Residence Hall A (unmarried quarters) (20m²):

Entrance Fee: JPY 35,000 (equal to one month's rent)

Rent: JPY 35,000 (monthly)

Utility, telephone and internet access charges must be paid by the individual students

Residence Hall B (unmarried quarters) (30m²):

Entrance Fee: JPY 52,000 (equal to one month's rent)

Rent: JPY 52,000 (monthly)

Utility, telephone and internet access charges must be paid by the individual students

Residence Hall C (married quarters for couples):

Entrance Fee: JPY 74,500 (equal to one month's rent)

Rent: JPY 74,500 (monthly)

Utility, telephone and internet access charges must be paid by the individual students

Residence Hall D (family quarters):

Entrance Fee: JPY 86,500 (equal to one month's rent)

Rent: JPY 86,500 (monthly)

Utility, telephone and internet access charges must be paid by the individual students

2. Move-in date and Period of Stay

Move-in date: between March 1, 2021 and February 1, 2022

Period of Stay: during the regular number of years of the current course and less than 3 years in total

- ✧ A resident might not be able to move in the premise on the date he or she desired, depending on the actual date that previous residents move out.
- ✧ If a resident takes a leave of absence from the University, he or she will be required to vacate the premises immediately even before his or her period of stay ends.
- ✧ If a resident has lived in TIEC, then the total length of the period of stay, including all the other occupancy periods, will be less than three years.
- ✧ Maximum length of Residence Permit is one year. Need some procedures to extend.

3. Eligibility for application

- International students who have enrolled in the regular course in the University of Tokyo with the status of residence of “Student” (This includes research students who have an enrolment certificate.)
- New international students who have Certificate of Admission at the time of the application and will stay with the status of residence of “Student” (New students may start to live there from 30 days before their enrolment.)

- (6) Copy of both sides of your Residence card (copies for spouse or children are also required at the time of submission if you wish for them to live with you). ※New students haven't arrived yet in Japan need not submit.

For Applicable Persons Only

- (7) When a student wishes to live with his or her family members or relatives, the applicant is required to submit a document which certifies the relation with such a person (copy is acceptable). ※If the documents are in the languages other than Japanese and English, please submit A4-size papers translated into Japanese or English with your signature or seal.
