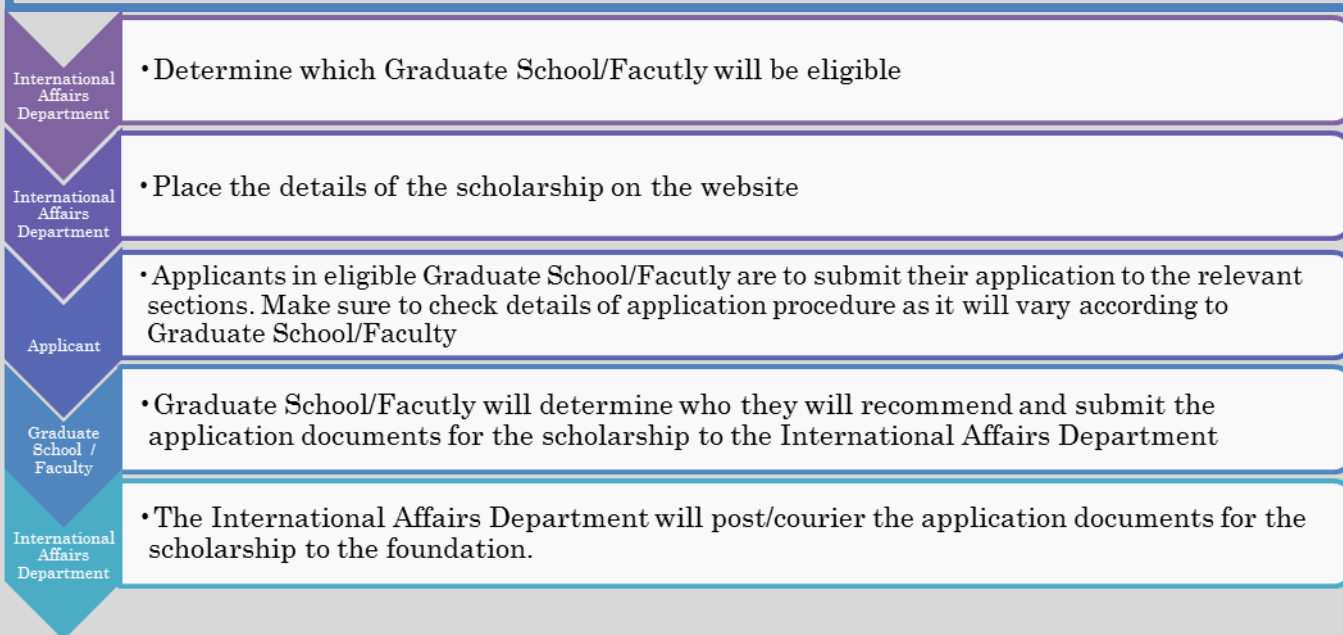

Some points about Scholarships requiring University Recommendations

- Application for scholarships from private foundations which require recommendations from the University are made through ***the relevant section of your Faculty or Graduate School**. Please make sure to check the details of the application procedures as it will vary according to the Graduate School or Faculty.
- The scholarships being offered at the University of Tokyo varies depending on your Graduate School, Faculty as well as your academic year. You will not be able to apply to all the scholarships that are listed on the website.

Some points about scholarships which are applied directly

- Applicants will apply directly to the foundations for this type of scholarships. Any queries about application or selections processes are to be made to the foundations.
- Please make sure to inform the relevant section of your Graduate School/Faculty of the selection results (including when you continue to receive the scholarship).

Points which are common to both types of scholarships

- Please make sure you read the application guidelines carefully and check your eligibility.
- Please follow the instructions of the International Students and Researchers Support Group and the relevant section of your Graduate School/Faculty concerning eligibility to apply and receive scholarships.
- Generally, you will not be able to receive multiple scholarships. Also, those who have been recommended for, already confirmed or scheduled to receive scholarships are not allowed to apply for other scholarships (except when allowed by the foundation).
- Please ensure you advise the relevant sections of your withdrawal from university, taking leave of absence, departure from Japan for overseas, as well as changes in contact details such as addresses, phone numbers or e-mail addresses while you are applying for, confirmed or scheduled to receive or are already receiving scholarships.
