- (1) Self-supporting international students, who are enrolled in the <u>master's or doctoral</u> <u>course</u> at the Graduate School of Agricultural and Life Sciences or the Faculty of Agriculture as of April 1, 2022. <u>(Those who have not yet passed the entrance examination are not eligible to apply.)</u>
- (2) With excellent academic records (GPA of last year should be 2.50 or above and expected to maintain the level of the GPA during the scholarship tenure period).
- *Grade points should be calculated according to a formula specified by MEXT.
- (3) With a nationality of a country listed in <u>attached 1</u>.
- (4) Born on or after April 2, 1987 (graduate level)
- (5) In good mental and physical health and can carry out academic responsibilities in the university without trouble.
- (6) Scholarship will not be awarded to the following. If the following cases arise after receiving the scholarship, recipients will be ordered to decline the scholarship:
 - ① Who will receive other scholarships (excluding grants for research).
 - ② Who was unable to complete the course within the standard course term.
