1. Application Period

From Wednesday, November 18, 2025 (10:00 a.m.) to Tuesday, November 24, 2025 (5:00 p.m.)

Please read the application guidelines carefully before applying.

2. Foreign Language (English) Examination

Submit official TOEFL-iBT or TOEFL-iBT Home Edition scores.

For details, please refer to "7. Foreign Language(English) Examination" in the Application Guidelines.

3. Specialized Subjects Examination

At the time of application, one subject must be selected from both Group 1 and Group 2.

(Group 1) Select one subject from 1) Rural Land and Environmental Engineering, 2) Water Environmental Engineering, 3) Soil Physics and Soil Hydrology, 4) Bioenvironmental Engineering, 5) Biological and Mechanical Engineering, 6) Bioprocess Engineering, 7) Biological and Environmental Information Engineering, 8) Sustainable Agro-ecosystem Engineering, 9) Ecological Safety Studies.

(Group 2) Basic questions will be asked in specialized subjects.

Select one subject from 1) Mathematics, 2) Physics, 3) Chemistry, or 4) Biology.

The examination will be conducted in a face-to-face written format (questions will be given in Japanese).
