(1) Foreign Language (English)

Applicants must submit official TOEFL-iBT or TOEFL-iBT Home Edition scores. Please refer to "7. Foreign Language (English) Examination" in the Application Guideline for the submission method.

(2) Specialized Subjects

At the time of application, students must select one subject from the following fields which they wish to specialize in: 1) Wood Physics, 2) Wood-based Materials and Timber Engineering, 3) Paper Science, 4) Forest Chemistry, 5) Wood Chemistry, 6) Polymeric Materials, 7) Adhesion Science and Bio-composites, 8) Sustainable Material Design, 9) Cellulose Chemistry.
