1. Application Period

From Wednesday, June 18, 2025 (10:00 a.m.) to Tuesday, June 24, 2025 (5:00 p.m.)
Please read the Application Guideline carefully before applying.

2. Written Examinations

(1) Foreign Language (English)

Applicants must take the TOEFL-ITP (LEVEL 1) administered by the Graduate School.

For details, please refer to "7. Foreign Language (English) Examination" in the Application Guideline.

(2) Specialized Subject

Animal Resource Sciences is required.

The examination will be conducted in-person at the Graduate School in a written format (questions will be given in both Japanese and English, and answers are to be given in either Japanese or English).

Submit official TOEFL-iBT or TOEFL-iBT Home Edition scores.

(2) Specialized Subject

Animal Resource Sciences is required.

The examination will be conducted in-person at the Graduate School in a written format (questions will be written in English and to be answered in either Japanese or English).

3. Oral Examination

Conducted online.

4. Examination Dates

The examination will be held from Thursday, January 29 to Friday, February 6, 2026.

Notification on the date, time, and other details of the examination will be provided in the "Guidelines for Examinees" to be sent to examinees by e-mail in early January 2026.
