1. Application Period

From Wednesday, June 18, 2025 (10:00 a.m.) to Tuesday, June 24, 2025 (5:00 p.m.).
Please read the Application Guideline carefully before applying.

2. Written Examinations

(1) Foreign Language (English)

As a rule, applicants must submit official TOEFL-iBT or TOEFL-iBT Home Edition scores. In unavoidable cases, TOEFL-Essentials scores will be accepted. We will not respond to individual inquiries as to what cases constitute a compelling case. Please refer to "7. Foreign Language (English) Examination" in the Application Guideline for the submission method.

(2) Specialized Subjects

Two examinations must be taken.

That is, at the time of application, the applicant must select one subject from the following nine subjects as their specialized field of his/her choice: 1) Global Fisheries Science and Policy, 2) Global Animal Resource Science, 3) Global Plant Resources, 4) Global Plant Material Sciences, 5) Global Forest Environmental Studies, 6) Plant Biotechnology, 7) Agricultural Development Studies, 8) International Environmental Economics and 9) International Agro-Informatics, and one essay on 10) International Development.

The examinations will be conducted in a written format online (questions will be given in either Japanese or English). Select your preferred language of examination (Japanese or English) at the time of application.

3. Oral Examination

Details of the oral examination will be provided in the "Guidelines for Examinees" sent by e-mail in early July or in an e-mail communication from the department.

4. Examination Dates

Written examination: Thursday, August 7, 2025

Oral Examination: Friday, August 8, 2025

Notification on the specific dates, times, method of implementation, and other details will be provided in the “Guidelines for Examinees” to be sent by e-mail in early July 2025.

5. Documents to be submitted

Documents to be submitted should be submitted (a) through (e), (g) and (h) in accordance with "10. Application Documents" in the Application Guideline.

6. October Admission
