1. Application Period

From Wednesday, June 18, 2025 (10:00 a.m.) to Tuesday, June 24, 2025 (5:00 p.m.).
Please read the Application Guideline carefully before applying.

2. Written Examinations

(1) Foreign Language (English)

Submit official TOEFL-iBT or TOEFL-iBT Home Edition scores.

Please refer to "7. Foreign Language (English) Examination" in the Application Guideline for the submission method.

(2) Specialized Subjects

At the time of application, students must select two courses from the following eight subjects: 1) Fisheries Dynamics, 2) Aquaculture Biology, 3) Organic Chemistry and Food Chemistry of Aquatic Organisms, 4) Aquatic Zoology, 5) Aquatic Animal Physiology, 6) Aquatic Environmental Biology, 7) Biochemistry and Molecular Biology of Aquatic Organisms, 8) Aquatic Ecology

The examination will be conducted face-to-face in a written format (questions will be given in Japanese).

 - a. All designated fields must be filled in. If any field is not filled in, the application will be treated as incomplete.

You may enter another faculty member in the same specialty as a second or third choice. If you do not have a second or third choice, you do not have to enter it.

2. Written Examinations

(2) Specialized Subjects

At the time of application, students must select two courses from the following eight subjects: 1) Fisheries Dynamics, 2) Aquaculture Biology, 3) Organic Chemistry and Food Chemistry of Aquatic Organisms, 4) Aquatic Zoology, 5) Aquatic Animal Physiology, 6) Aquatic Environmental Biology, 7) Biochemistry and Molecular Biology of Aquatic Organisms, 8) Aquatic Ecology

The examination will be conducted online in a written format (questions in English, answers in English).

4. Examination Dates

The examinations will be conducted over two days from Thursday, January 29, 2026, to Friday, February 6, 2026.

6. October Admission

This department does not offer October admission.
