The following is a supplement to the Application Guideline for the 2025 for the Doctoral Course, Graduate School of Agricultural and Life Sciences, the University of Tokyo.

For the General Admissions and the Special Admissions for Working Adults for the Doctoral Program of the Department of Ecosystem Studies, only Schedule B will be conducted.

**<Schedule B>**

**1. Application Period**

From Thursday, November 21, 2024 (10:00 a.m.) to Wednesday, November 27, 2024 (5:00 p.m.)

Please read the Application Guideline carefully before applying.

**2. Written Examinations**

**(1) Foreign Language (English)**

Applicants must submit official TOEFL-iBT or TOEFL-iBT Home Edition scores. Please refer to "7. Written Examination (Foreign Languages)" in the Application Guideline for the submission method.

Please note that this major requires applicants to have already obtained a score at the time of application. In other words, be sure to check "(1) I have a score to submit (score already obtained)" in the Web Entry System at the time of application and perform the following (a) and (b) on the Web Entry System during the application period.

(a) Register (enter) the Appointment Number and test date of the score to be submitted.

(b) Upload the scanned data (PDF) of the Test Taker Score Report in (a) above.

**(2) Specialized Subjects**

At the time of application, students must select one subject from the following fields in which they wish to specialize: 1) Biodiversity Science, 2) Conservation Ecology, 3) Landscape Ecology & Planning, 4) Forest Ecosystem Management, 5) Aquatic Ecosystem Conservation, 6) Agro-Field Ecology Studies, 7) Biology of Aquatic Organisms, 8) Forest Ecosystems, 9) Forest Functional Biology, 10) Forest and Human Society Relationship, 11) Forest and Water Resources Management.

The examination will be conducted in a face-to-face written format (questions will be given in both Japanese and English).

\*Examinations in foreign languages and specialized subjects will be administered or waived based on the following table.

Documents to be submitted should be (a) through (e), and (g) through (n) in accordance with "10. Application Documents" in the Application Guideline.

The documents "(n) Documents required to be submitted by the department" should be submitted as shown in the table below.

## 6. October Admission

Those who meet the application qualifications specified in the Application Guideline may apply for admission in October 2025. Applicants must upload the form "(m) Application for admission in October" from "10. Application Documents" in the Application Guideline to the Web Entry System during the application period.

## 7. Other matters

(1) Notes on inputting information into the Web Entry System

- a. All designated fields must be filled in. If any field is not filled in, the application will be treated as incomplete.
  - b. Enter the desired field of specialization and the desired academic advisor(s) by referring to the "List of faculty members and their fields of specialization".  
Also, if there are any changes in the names of faculty members, etc., please check the latest version of the "List of faculty members and their fields of specialization" in the Application Guideline before applying.
  - c. Be sure to enter the name of the subject you will take in the "Examination Subject" column.
  - d. Please enter your history up to the date of completion of your Master's degree (expected). Applicants for the Special Admissions for Working Adults should enter their employment history.
  - e. If you have jumped years or have been educated outside Japan, please contact the Graduate Student Section, Academic Affairs Division, Graduate School of Agricultural and Life Sciences (see "14. Inquiries and Contacts" in the Application Guideline) for information on how to enter your educational background.
- (2) Contact your prospective supervisor well in advance of application in order to confirm the matching of research themes, etc.
- (3) Previous years' questions can be viewed at the Student Service Center, Graduate School of Agricultural and Life Sciences.
- (4) If you have any questions about the entrance examination for this department, please contact the Department of Ecosystem Studies (see "Contact Information for Each Department" in the Application Guideline).
- (5) Please read the Application Guideline and this Admission Guide for the Graduate School Admission Examination carefully. If you have any questions about the
