# Qualifications of Residence (must satisfy all the following conditions during the period of residence in the Dorm):

- (1) Self-supporting international students enrolled in the regular graduate school, with nationality other than Japanese. (Research Students are not eligible to apply.)
- (2) With the "Student" status of residence (Those who are expected to obtain the status are also eligible to apply.)
- (3) A person with a high level of poverty
- (4) Have interest in and contribute to international understanding and friendship.
- (5) Able to communicate in Japanese. (Elementary level included)
- (6) Those who abide by "Applicant's Agreement" on Application Forms.

Residence period: 1 year from October, 2025 to September, 2026. (One year contract. Extension will be considered only once, maximum 2 years. A half year contract will be possible with permission of the foundation (Accommodation fee: 60,000 Yen). Actual move-in date depends on the previous resident's room- check date, and it will take about a week to move in after this check.)
