Accommodation Information

The Student Dorm Oak Village (Kashiyama Scholarship Foundation)

Qualifications of Residence (must satisfy all the following conditions during the period of residence in the Dorm):

- (1) Self-supporting international students enrolled in the regular graduate school, with nationality other than Japanese. (Research Students are not eligible to apply.)
- (2) With the “Student” status of residence (Those who are expected to obtain the status are also eligible to apply.)
- (3) A person with a high level of poverty
- (4) Have interest in and contribute to international understanding and friendship.
- (5) Able to communicate in Japanese. (Elementary level included)
- (6) Those who abide by “Applicant’s Agreement” on Application Forms.

Number: 2

Residence period: 1 year from October, 2025 to September, 2026. (One year contract. Extension will be considered only once, maximum 2 years. A half year contract will be possible with permission of the foundation (Accommodation fee: 60,000 Yen). Actual move-in date depends on the previous resident’s room check date, and it will take about a week to move in after this check.)

Accommodation Fee (*): 120,000 Yen/year (equivalent to 12 months’ facility service charge) *There is no deduction in this amount even for those living less than one year.

*Only lump sum payment will be accepted.

Deadline for application: Submit the required documents to the International Student Section by email or in person by 17:00pm of July 14, 2025 (Mon)

Documents to be submitted:

- (1) ②Application Form the Student Dorm Oak Village
- (2) ③Application for Admission to the Student Dorm Oak Village
- (3) Copy of Student ID Card
- (4) Copy of Residence Card (both sides)
- (5) Documents certifying the amount of income for one month
 - i . For those who make a living by sending money or withdrawing savings, a copy of the bank balance certificate or a copy of the savings passbook.
 - ii . For those who are currently working part-time in Japan, a document that shows the amount of salary. (if no document is available, a “④Statement (Certification) Regarding Part-time Work”)
