If you wish to live in the University of Tokyo International Student Housing from October 2025, please apply through OSTA (Online System for Todai Accommodations) as follows. Applications for the 【International Lodge】 and 【International Halls of Residence】 are accepted once every six months, so if you wish to live in the dormitory, please be sure to apply during the period.

## 1. Eligibility

- (1) International students (including research students) enrolled in the University of Tokyo as of October, 2025.
- (2) Students applying for a couple or family room should note that all family members who will live together are required to move in together.
- (3) Students who fall under the following categories are not eligible to apply. (\*1):
  - (a) Foreign residents in Japan with permanent residency
  - (b) Students who lived in the University of Tokyo International Student Dormitory for six months and more during the past three years as of October, 2025 (except previous stay in MITAKA International Hall of Residence when you were the first or second year of undergraduate students)
  - (c) Students extending the regular study period (only for MITAKA/TOSHIMA International Hall of Residence).

\*1: Students who fall under (b) are eligible to apply for Mejirodai International Village and International Lodge KASHIWA.
