**Eligibility:** PhD Students enrolled in the University of Tokyo

(If you will be enrolled at the Doctoral course from 1<sup>st</sup> of October, 2022, “Notification of Acceptance” is mandatory. Only those who are in the standard period are eligible)

**Available Rooms:** about 25 Single Rooms

**Application Deadline:** 2023/8/23 (Wed.) 17:00

**The Selection Result:** Around mid September

\*Not on a first-come/first-served basis

\*From September 1st, applications will be accepted every month for doctoral course students. Please submit the application form to our team via email. The deadline is the 20th of every month, and the notification of the selection results is around the 15th of the following month.

#### Eligibility

\*International students and Japanese students who are enrolled in the doctoral course of UTokyo (with notification of acceptance)

\*Students who have already been selected for another dormitory cannot accept this application.

\*If enrollment in the doctoral course is not confirmed by the end of the application period, the application will be cancelled.

**Permitted Period of Stay:** Basically from 2 weeks up to 1 year.

(The permitted term of stay can be renewed upon request every year up to the end of the regular term of enrollment for the student's course duration at University of Tokyo)

**Selection Criteria:**

If the number of applicants exceeds the number of rooms applied for, a lottery will be held.

**Fees:**

Accommodation Fee: 64,000yen (monthly)

Entrance Fee: 66,000yen (One-off Expenses)

Common Service Fees: 2,000yen (monthly)

Utilities & Internet Access Fees: 10,800yen (monthly) \*Revised to 14,500 yen (monthly) after April 1, 2024

Renewal fee: 66,000 yen (charged at the time of renewal every year)
