#### **Qualifications:**

(1) International students enrolled in the undergraduate or graduate school course at the University of Tokyo with a “student” status of residence (excluding leave of absence), with no experience in repeating the same school year.

(2) Able to submit recommendation letter (mentioned Academic record, Character and Potential, etc...) written by your supervisor.

(3) Principle, international students who do not receive a scholarship of more than 100,000 Yen per month. ※

※However the application from scholarship recipients is accepted, the priority is given to those in need.

(4) Familiar with Japanese customs including food and able to communicate in Japanese.

(5) Able to adapt to community living and are cooperative, especially those who can obey the rules of employee dormitory and daily life manners.

- (6) Exchange with the employee and participate to the association event in the willing manner.
- (7) With national health insurance.
- (8) Not doing part-time jobs in the midnight through the morning.
- (9) Will have “Comprehensive renters insurance for foreign students studying in Japan” when the company accepts you as a resident.
- (10) Who have not lived in the employee dormitories in the past, remaining residence period in the University of Tokyo International Student Dormitory after May2024,ether..

**Deadline for application:**

Apply to the International Student Section by 5pm of February 22.2024 (Thu))

**Documents to be submitted:**

- (1) Application form (handwriting)
- (2) Copy of Residence Card (both sides)
- (3) Copy of Student ID

**Selection procedure:**

(1) International Student Welfare Team (Hongo Campus) will announce to the candidates to hold an interview in the beginning of March after they accept the submitted application forms And then the team will decide the names of candidates to be recommended from the University of Tokyo. After that, the candidates need to prepare the documents to be submitted to the company . International Student Welfare Team will contact you within mid-March to late March.

(2) After the screening of submitted documents, the company will hold an interview for the candidates. Please note that candidates who submit the documents to the company cannot withdraw the application. Normally, it will take few weeks to one month for the final result to be announced after the candidates submit the documents to the company.

**Important note:**

- (1) Residents are required to leave the dormitory on the expiration date specified in the permit issued by the company. It might be possible to extend the residence period if the students proceed to higher level of education. However, even in that case, the residence period will be (at most) until the last day of the fourth academic year since you move-in. Those graduating from undergraduate course or transferring to another school must leave the dormitory.
- (2) Those who violate the rules described in the announcement (distributed to the

students recommended from the University) or cause trouble to other residents, are required to leave the dormitory according to the regulation specified in the announcement.
