The University of Tokyo is accepting application for TIEC Residence Hall rooms (hereinafter referred to as Residence Hall).

Students who wish to live in Residence Hall rooms need to submit required documents during the specified application period.

Please note that the selection process is carried out by TIEC and not the University of Tokyo.

1. Type of room and rent

- ▲ As the final selection is made by TIEC, the receipt of application by the University does not guarantee allocation of rooms.
- ▲ Internet connection services must be applied by the residents as needed basis.

Residence Hall A (for singles) (20m²):

Entrance Fee: JPY 35,000 (equal to one month's rent)

Rent: JPY 35,000 (monthly)

Utility, telephone and internet access charges must be paid by the individual students

Residence Hall B (for singles) (30m²):

Entrance Fee: JPY 52,000 (equal to one month's rent)

Rent: JPY 52,000 (monthly)

Utility, telephone and internet access charges must be paid by the individual students

Residence Hall C (for families and couples) (80m²):

Entrance Fee: JPY 74,500 (equal to one month's rent)

Rent: JPY 74,500 (monthly)

Utility, telephone and internet access charges must be paid by the individual students

Residence Hall D (for families and couples) (100m²):

Entrance Fee: JPY 86,500 (equal to one month's rent)

Rent: JPY 86,500 (monthly)

Utility, telephone and internet access charges must be paid by the individual students

* Rent and entrance fees are scheduled to be revised on March 1, 2027, and March 1, 2031.

2. Move-in date and Period of Stay

Move-in date: between March 1, 2026 and February 28, 2027

Period of Stay: during the regular number of years of the current course and less than 3 years in total

※ Notes:

- If a resident takes a leave of absence from the University, he or she will be required to vacate the premises immediately even before his or her period of stay ends.
- If a resident has lived in TIEC, then the total length of the period of stay, including all the other occupancy periods, will be less than three years.
- Maximum length of Residence Permit is one year. Need some procedures for extension.

3. Eligibility for application

- International students who have enrolled in the regular course in the University of Tokyo with the status of residence of “Student” (This includes research students who have an enrolment certificate.)
- New international students who have Certificate of Admission at the time of the application and will stay with the status of residence of “Student” (New students may start to live there from 30 days before their enrolment.)
- Outstanding international students who have not exceeded the standard period of enrollment.

4. Required Documents

All Applicants ※single-side printing

 - (4) Copy of Student ID card ※New students from April need to submit a copy of Certificate of Admission
 - (5) Copy of passport showing the ID photo, landing permit and visa (copies for spouse or children are also required at the time of submission if you wish for them to live with you).
 - (6) Copy of both sides of your Residence card (copies for spouse or children are also required at the time of submission if you wish for them to live with you).
- ※New students who haven’t arrived in Japan yet do not need to submit.

For Qualified Applicants Only

- (7) When a student wishes to live with his or her family members or relatives, the applicant is required to submit a document which certifies the relation with such a person (copy is acceptable). ※If the documents are written in the languages other than Japanese or English, please submit a translation written in Japanese or English in format A4 with your signature.
