UTokyo Foundation, UTokyo Foundation Scholarship Information

1. The University of Tokyo Foundation for Supporting International Students (including Masuda M. Masato Scholarship) –2nd announcement for 2022

Qualifications:

Self-supported international students who satisfy all the following conditions:

- (1) With excellent academic records and character.
- (2) Regular students or research students enrolled in the graduate school as of October 2022 and expected to be registered throughout the year. (As for the Masuda M Masato Scholarship, preference will be given to students from Taiwan.)

*Student who will still be registered even though they exceed the standard course duration may also apply.

- (3) With a “student” status of residence.
- (4) In need of financial assistance.
- (5) Not receiving other scholarships (in excess of JPY 50,000 per month).

*Applicants who are still employed by and receiving salaries from government agencies or other organizations in their home country while they are studying overseas are not eligible to apply.

- (6) Should not be overseas on long trip/long-term research or take a leave of absence during the scholarship grant period.

Number: 1

Scholarship amount per month: JPY 50,000

Scholarship grant period: 6 month (October 2022 ~ March 2023)

Extension will not be considered.

Deadline for application: Apply to the International Student Section by 5pm October 12, 2022 (Wed). Applicants must abide by the deadline and submit application on time.

Documents to be submitted:

- (1) Application form (Form 1)
- (2) Copy of Residence Card (both sides)
- (3) Copy of academic record certificates (all certificates from the undergraduate course to the course currently enrolled in)
- (4) List of Achievements (Form 3)

* You don't need to submit the documents (2) ~ (4) if you have applied other scholarships in 2022 through our school and the information hasn't changed.
